### 1. Key Information

We would like to remind everyone to park responsibly and considerately when dropping off or collecting children from school.

The camera on the zebra crossing outside the school is actively monitoring the area and is issuing fines for illegal parking. Unfortunately, a significant number of Penalty Charge Notices have recently been issued:

- November: 33 fines
- December: 28 fines
- January: 18 fines

Please help us keep all children and families safe by avoiding parking on the crossing, zig-zag lines, or in restricted areas. If possible, consider parking a short distance away and walking the remainder of the journey.
