CRIW CYMRAEG

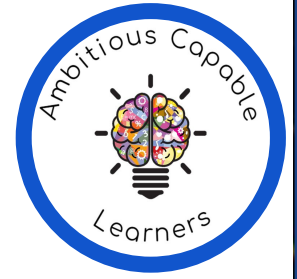

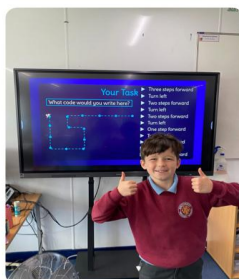
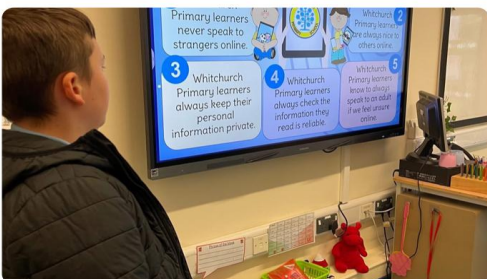
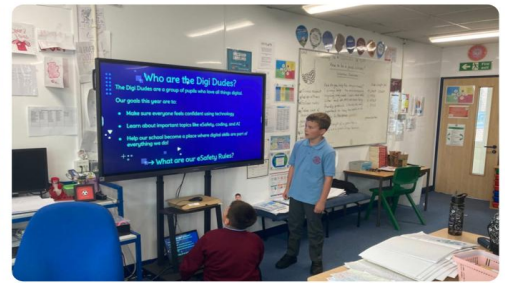
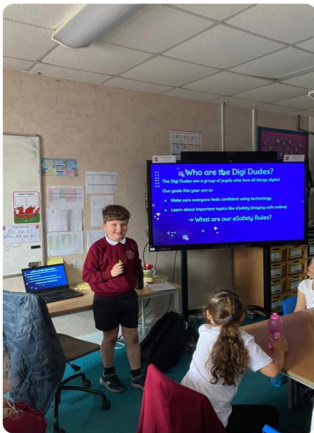


DIGI DUDES
