Our fortnightly bike bus has started again.



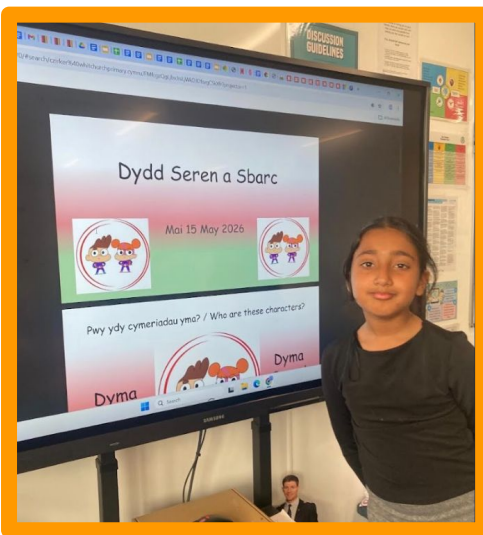
The active travel crew designed and led scooter skills lessons for 1DB.

CRIW CYMRAEG

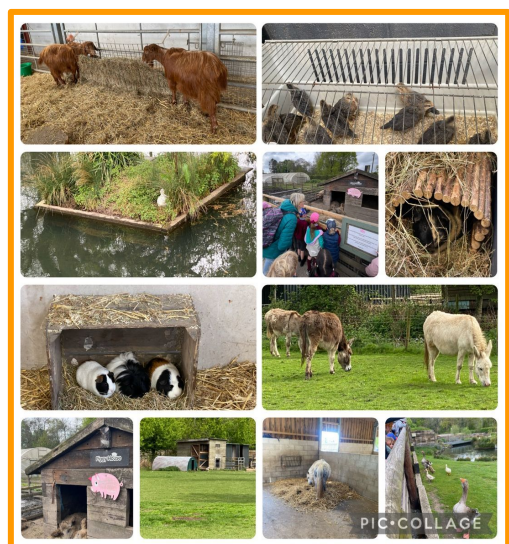
The Criw Cymraeg supported their friends to celebrate Diwrnod Seren a Sbarc, a day where we celebrated speaking Welsh.

CHICKS

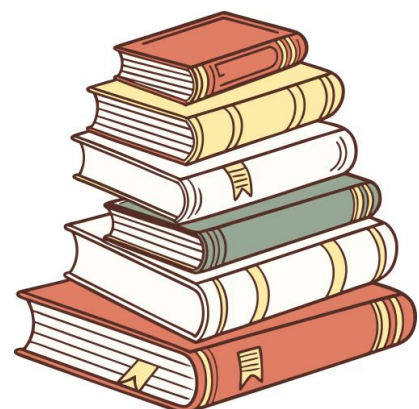
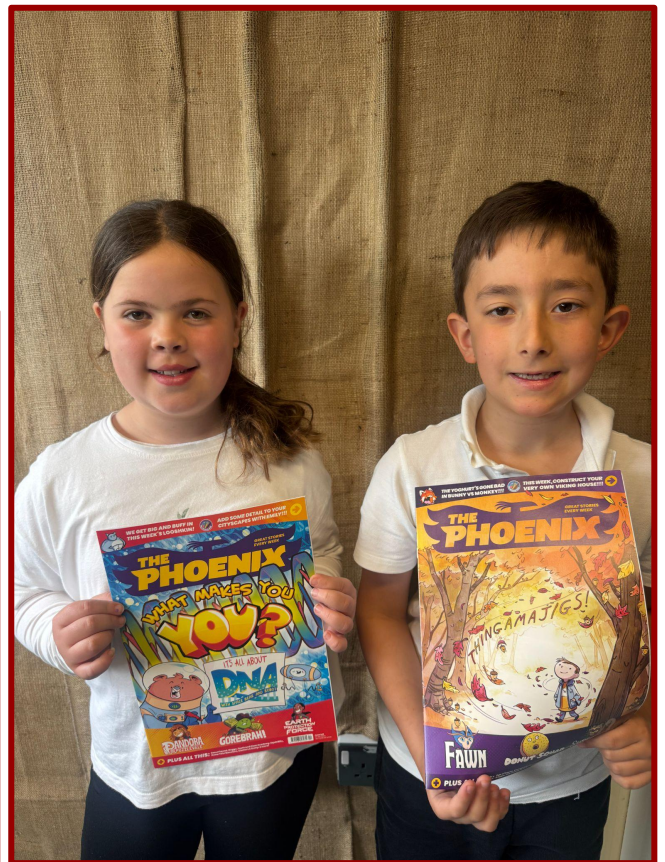
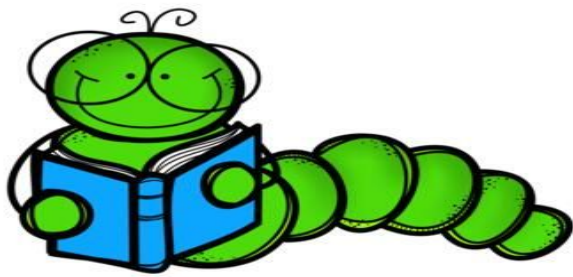

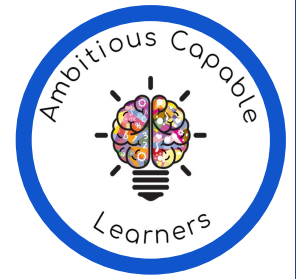
Our chicks at Walnut Tree Farm.

READING AMBASSADORS

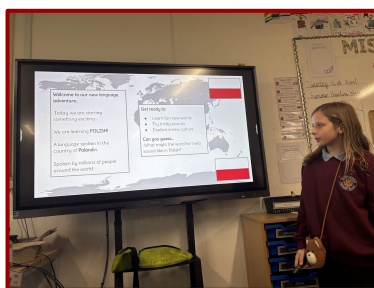
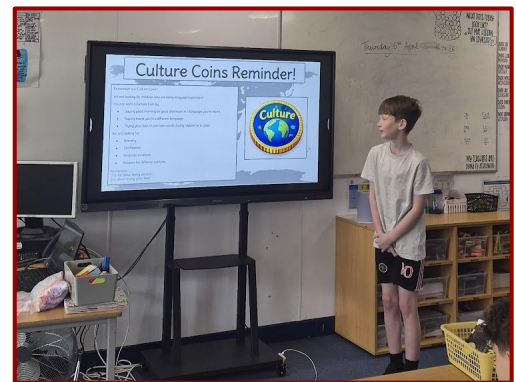
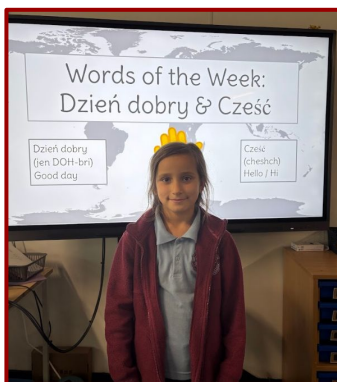
